## **The 2010 DC Francophonie Festival to Host Annual Discothèque**

*With Electronic Music Group Make The Girl Dance from Paris*

**Washington DC, March 19** – The DC Francophonie Festival will host the second annual Discothèque electro-house music night at 9pm at the National Postal Museum (2 Massachusetts Ave, NE). Parisian DJ sensation *Make The Girl Dance* begins their U.S. tour as the featured performers of this popular dance party, turning the Smithsonian venue into an international nightclub for 800 guests.

*Make The Girl Dance* is composed of Pierre Mathieu (former host for French television stations M6 and Canal +) and Greg Kozo, known on the House music scene for more than 10 years. The risqué music video of their sarcastic hit “Baby, Baby, Baby” has created a buzz around the world, with over 6 million hits on DailyMotion and Consorts since its summer release.

Known as “The Vibe Conductor” by his fans, opening act *DJ Stylus* applies a mix of soul and hip-hop to a palette of tunes ranging from overlooked classics to the newest progressive electronic sounds. This Wammie award-winning artist has rocked the turntables for the likes of Erykah Badu and The Roots.
